



THE PROBLEM I Moyo is a remote location in the West Nile sub-region of Uganda. It is in the northwest corner and shares borders with the Democratic Republic of the Congo and South Sudan. It also hosts more than half of the 1.5 million refugees in the country. The lack of reliable power, water, paved roads, and internet, combined with the highest levels of food insecurity and poverty, creates a difficult environment for improving health outcomes. These conditions are particularly detrimental to maternal and newborn health, impacting both general health and access to essential services. Additionally access to continuing medical education and training is almost nonexistent and the shortage of skilled healthcare workers contributes to the poor healthcare outcomes.

OUR SOLUTION I Pipeline Worldwide is building Lonyi Village, a 3.4 acre humanitarian lodging and training campus in Moyo, Uganda. In addition to lodging and dining, the campus will include an Innovation Learning Center that will include a virtual learning classroom/internet cafe, hands-on learning lab, and a simulation container lab. This center will bring continuing medical education and training to the West Nile sub-region through our collaboration partners resulting in accelerated and increased impact.
